

Poster Competition "My 3D Landscape" for Digital Landscape Architecture 2017, June 7-10 in Bernburg, Germany

Travel grant (submission by May 10, 2017): Aiste Ambrzeviciute and Stefan Eklöf

By May 10, 2017, we could award Aiste Ambrzeviciute and Stefan Eklöf a travel grant of 250 € each.

By May 30, 2017, the DLA conference team had received 42 posters online and published them in the DLA 2017 brochure (www.kolleg.loel.hs-anhalt.de/landschaftsinformatik/fileadmin/user_upload/temp/2017/DLA17_brochure.pdf) with the technical information given. We posted these posters at the conference as A3 sheets on individual boards.

Fifteen of the poster authors hung their original sized A1 posters on these boards. A number of authors also provided links to the "4D" online versions of their posters.

Many posters show highly sophisticated digital landscape architecture applications.

The 125 conference participants had been asked to evaluate each poster between 1 (weak) and 5 (outstanding) points.

The results of this evaluation of the exhibition between June 8 and 9, 2017 lead to the following ranking:
